**Los Molinos: Masonic Hall Tuesday 20th at 25020 Tehama-Vina Road
 Between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon**

Rancho Tehama: The Recreation Center – Monday 19th between 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Paynes Creek: at 30100 Hwy 36E 8:00 to 5:00 on the 16th

Ponderosa Sky Ranch: 18889 Juniper Ave 2:00PM to 6:00 on the 16th

Manton: at 31555 Forward Rd. 11:00AM to 2:00 on the 16th

Eligibility: Guidelines for those with low income are set by the Federal Government as follows:

All other sites in the county will be at the usual time and places.

Income is **GROSS** monthly income, not **NET**. **ALL INCOME MUST BE REPORTED**.
 Rules for eligibility and participation in the donated commodity program are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, age, sex, national origin, handicap, religious persuasion or sexual preference. Self certification that the recipient’s income is within the program’s guidelines is necessary. Must give a physical address.
